We Light Up the Night: Elizabeth DiGiovanni, A Solo Show

In this show Elizabeth DiGiovanni presents four colored pencil drawings of candelabras taken from a larger ongoing series which represents a list of figures from elementary school to the present day. The list is drawn from broadly defined categories of film, music, and personal encounters and focuses on a mix of her obsessive crushes and aspirational models. The formal aspects of the drawings play off DiGiovanni's interest in the heavily ornamentation of Baroque religious artifacts along with the dual meaning of luminary as both a person of prominence and a body that gives light.

Elizabeth DiGiovanni is from Los Angeles and received a Master of Fine Arts in New Genres from the San Francisco Art Institute in 2005. DiGiovanni's art is sentimental, nostalgic, romantic, and mystical which all these qualities are a part of her sensibility.
